C *ompost activity decomposes *Nutri-Peat* into rich humus! Promoting healthy soil activity, i.e. earthworms and beneficial microbes.*

D *eepening your soil's tilth and friability by adding moisture retention in the planting beds. It also protects plants from stress during arid portions of the growing season thus insuring your investment from drought damage.*

E *nhances your soil's natural resistance to nasty fungi like artillery (shotgun) spores, pesky mushrooms, molds and other undesirable growths. This is something you won't achieve with ground wood mulches!*

Simple Recommended Application Process:

Step 1

Assess your beds for remaining mulch thickness. Remove all existing mulch over 1-inch depth. (Excess wood reduces much needed nutrients from your soils.)

Step 2

Identify any existing weeds and design a control strategy to create a weed free bed. Come in to see us for recommendations. Edging your beds is highly recommended prior to *Nutri-Peat* application not only to create beautiful borders, but it also helps keep grasses and other weeds from encroaching through the growing season.

Step 3

The depth of *Nutri-Peat* application should be based on the quality of the soil in your beds and the types of plants. We recommend 2 to 3 inches especially as a first-time application.
